- The Fleur-de-Lis has long since been a symbolism in military units


OUR OFFICIAL LOGO

The Main Event

The Miss & Miss Teen Pageant – Augusta University Maxwell Theatre - FEB 1, 2026

The Pageant is a FORMAL Military Style event similar to a Change of Command, with Posting of the Colors, National Anthem, and invocation. Candidates are required to have a Military escort during the Evening Gown Phase.

A Candidate may have a family member (or a cadet of the Augusta University ROTC) as a stand in for any relative that has served, but has passed away, and that military honoree's name and service will be highlighted in the program magazine and during the Evening Gown introductions. This pageant is about bringing focus to the Military as well as providing scholarships to these young ladies and preparing them for a bright and successful future.

There are 3 wardrobe changes, Patriotic Wear for opening introductions, Runway Fashion and Evening Gown. There is no talent. There will be On-stage Questions for the semi-finalists that will derive from the candidate's personal application information. *Candidates will receive credit toward this Miss Entrepreneur Award for admission tickets sold in advance. Escort will receive free admission and is requested to be at the rehearsal.*

Additional Pageant Titles

- ☆ **Miss Charity** – Awarded to the candidate who has the most cumulative charity volunteer hours submitted. Total hours from the application and participation in the events leading up to the Pageant.
- ☆ **Miss Entrepreneur** – Awarded to the candidate that raises the most in Sponsorship support. Knowing that each personality is different there are those who are looking forward to a career in the public-sector and will enjoy promoting and attaining sponsorship support beyond the \$300 requirement.
- ☆ **Miss Spokesmodel** – Awarded to the candidate that has the best score during her personal interview with panel of 3 judges. They will be judged on professional appearance, eye contact, personal stature, and how well they articulate their answers.

Sponsorship & Ads \$300

Each contestant will receive a half page in the Pageant Magazine. They will have a feature photo, and space reserved for their sponsors along with a photo/military background info of their Escort. All sponsors must complete a sponsorship form and signed by the Pageant Candidate and Pageant Official.

This is an opportunity to realize the importance of harvesting support for any cause that they choose to pursue. We are a Non-Profit 501c3 Organization and advertising is a win-win for both the supporting Business and the future exposure of the Pageant. Nonetheless, it also expands the candidate's networking field and potential career opportunities.

Deadline is to ensure all sponsor Ads are set to go to print for the full color Pageant Magazine. Late fees turned in may result in ad space that is not available.

Judging Criteria

Application – Deadline January 31, 2026

The application will be points driven based on several Categories: The overall score will be tallied on the following sections from the application such as: GPA, Honors & Awards, Scholastic Activities, and Volunteer Hours in which they support their favorite charities.

Panel Interview – (date & times TBA)

There will be an interview with a panel of 3 judges that will be based on questions from the application. It is only limited to a casual discussion about the candidate, what she enjoys, and scholastic involvement along with either the Essay or Platform that was submitted. The main concentration the judges will be looking for is how well she is dressed professionally, eye contact, speech, and over all how she presents herself in the interview.

Essay or Platform– Due Jan 31, 2026 (scoring based on submission in reference to application date)

The Essay (see page one of application for topic and header info) should be 3-paragraphs, minimum 1 page double spaced and guidelines must be followed for the header criteria of their submission.

Military Core Value: this choice is to give the candidate a chance to research and understand the Values of the Military Branches and how they relate to their own personal values.

Platform: this choice is an option for the candidate to have a platform for any cause that they are currently supporting or wish to support in the future.

EITHER choice should include why the candidate would be an outstanding representation of this Military affiliated crown. Candidates should be prepared to speak on their essay to the Judges during the Panel Interview.

Pageant Fundraising Events

We are hosting several events leading up to the Pageant as listed below: Events that the candidates participate in and bring support of family/friends will count toward their pageant score, as well as dollar support will count toward their totals for the Miss Entrepreneur Award.



Jan 31, 2026

The Richmond on Greene. (8a-2p Conference) (2p-4p for candidate overview of pageant evening)

This will be a full day conference Sponsored by Security Federal and held at the Richmond On Greene. The Mission of this Pageant is to prepare these candidates to be ***“Young Ladies in Leadership”***. The morning speaker topics include: Branding a Savvy You, Self-Esteem Building, Interview skills, Business Etiquette, Military Etiquette, Financial Security, Safety both Personal and Online, ideas on how to raise funds for advertising sponsors, Military Careers for Women and Cyber Community Careers as well.

Lunch will be provided for the Participants. The afternoon will be team building events and an online Tour of Maxwell Theatre consisting of a walk-thru of the stage area, dressing room assignments and overall what is expected for the Pageant Performance. We ask that the Parent/Guardian and Military Escort attend the latter session from 2-4p so they can be briefed on details of the event. However, if the Parent/Guardian and the Escort would like to stay for the full day activities, we ask that you complete the selection on the **YLIL Registration Consent Form. (the form will be available online in April)**

The Workshop is open to any student (high school/college) and is a great way to earn leadership credits, as well as networking with leaders from the Community. Cost is free for Candidates who have submitted a Pageant application by the deadline. Cost is \$10 for other attendees which covers conference manual materials.

Candidates will receive credit for any friends (not entering the pageant) that attend the workshop. However, should any student decide to enter the Pageant, the \$10 will apply toward the application fee IF there are any slots remaining for entrance into the Pageant. (Pageant candidates are limited to first 50 applicants only)




